# HOW TO WRITE A COMPETITIVE CONCEPT NOTE THAT PUTS YOUR ORGANISATION ON A DONOR'S SHORTLIST

A concept is an outline or framework of the development project or program you seek funding. In short, a concept note is a simple summary of the proposal comprising similar ideas as in a proposal but in a less detailed manner. Note that on many occasions, a concept note is the first document that introduces your organisation's work, project concepts and ideas to new donors.

A concept note gives your organisation the flexibility to detail your project at later stages of proposal submission. On the other hand, it also helps the donors or funding organisations eliminate the proposals that are not likely to be funded because they are not in line with the donor's priorities or other reasons based on the concept note you submitted.

Understanding the 'bricks' that build a Concept Note is the first step toward submitting a Concept Note that attracts the donor's attention. The donor shortlists organisations whose Concept Notes align with the donor's intentions. Organisations whose Concept Notes have been shortlisted are requested to develop and present a full proposal for funding considerations.
